

EXPLANATION TO CONSTITUTION CHANGES & RESOLUTIONS FOR ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 17 MARCH 2024

The Incorporated Societies Act 2022 requires the following changes to the Society's Constitution:

- 1. The term 'Constitution' replaces the word 'Rules' throughout the document.
- 2. The word 'Resolution' replaces the word 'Motion' see Clauses 8(a) (iii) and (v)
- A member shall be deemed to have resigned if they fail to pay the annual subscription see Clause 3(b)
- 4. Those members putting their name forward to be elected to an officer and committee members <u>must</u> also complete the Consent and Certificate of Officer form See clauses 5 (b) and (c)
- 5. Officers and committee duties are explicitly set out and align with the directors' duties in the Companies Act 1993 –See Clause 6(c).
- 6. Dedicated contact person the Registrar requires the Society to have at least one contact person but no more than three. The president, secretary and treasurer are the contact persons for the Society See Clause 6(d)
- 7. The Society needs to arrange a financial review not an auditor See Clause 8(a) (ii)
- 8. The Society needs to have a Dispute and Complaints Procedure. It is proposed we adopt Clauses 1 to 8 of the Act "Optional dispute resolution procedure See Clause 14 and Appendix A as the procedure as set out in Appendix A is considered to be a "safe harbour" by the Act.

The Committee presents the following Resolutions be passed by the members at the AGM:

Clause 5(a) - currently the Committee is made up of a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer, the latter can also serve as the Secretary. Plus, no more than eleven (11) committee members, potentially making in total a committee of fifteen.

Proposed change: That there be no more than eight (8) committee members

Clause 8(d)(iii) - currently the requirement for a quorum at all general meetings is twenty (20) financial members.

Proposed Change: At all general meetings fifteen (15) financial members shall constitute a quorum.

Proposed by: Beverley Pearce Seconded by: Ann Paynter

NOTE: If accepted by the 2024 AGM, these two Resolutions/Amendments come into effect from the date of registration by the Registrar on Incorporated Societies, that is for the AGM in 2025. Section 34 Incorporated Societies Act 2022
